TWO JOB OPENINGS AT RECOVERY INSTITUTE

The Recovery Institute (RI) seeks two diversity minded individuals, who are in recovery, to serve in the following positions:

Peer Support Specialist Position

The ideal candidate will possess excellent verbal and written communication skills as well as ability to competently facilitate and teach a variety of groups or classes. Individual will need to demonstrate leadership and exceptional organizational skills. Job duties will include facilitating social and community opportunities and teaching recovery skills in different venues for RI Members. A willingness and capacity to share personal recovery experiences and to encourage others is essential. This is a forty (40) hour a week position that is part of the Recovery Institute's Living in Recovery Team and includes full benefits.

Peer Companion Position

This position involves visiting people in the community who are struggling with their recovery and or feelings of loneliness and isolation. Peer Companions offer social support and an introduction to recovery oriented community supports and activities. This is a twelve (12) hour a week position that is part of the Recovery Institute's Living in Recovery Team and does not include benefits.

The Recovery Institute is a peer-driven non-profit agency that promotes recovery for people diagnosed with mental illness and substance use. All applicants must be able to demonstrate their experience in relationship to the types of guidance, support and mentoring activities they will provide and be generally recognized and accepted to peers. Applicants must have a High School Diploma *or* General Equivalency Degree (GED) and life experience that allows individual to identify self as a peer. Individual shall meet credentialing requirements; possess a valid and current driver's license as well as reliable transportation. Ability to obtain a chauffeur's license is necessary.
